Check list

1. Arrange for a neighbour or trusty friend to clear your letter box periodically and cancel regular news paper deliveries.
2. Leave an outdoor light on preferably with a motion detector switch.
3. Leave an indoor light or radio on preferably with a timer switch.
4. Advise your insurance company that you will be absent if it is over a two week period. Check your policy. It may become invalid otherwise.
5. Lock up ladders, wheel borrows and other easily removable items.
6. Don't hide your keys in the obvious place.
